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WESTERN PLAINS LIBRARY SYSTEM INTERNET ACCESS POLICY

Western Plains Library System (WPLS) provides access to internet-connected computers and Wi-Fi access to customers who provide their own devices. WPLS considers the use of any computer or the internet in any of its facilities to constitute an acceptance of this policy.

While the internet offers access to a wealth of material that is enriching, it also enables access to some material that may be offensive, disturbing and/or illegal. WPLS filters public internet access in compliance with all state and federal laws, including the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA). WPLS staff may disable the internet filter for bona fide research or other lawful purposes.

WPLS follows state and federal law regarding privacy of library users' records and information. WPLS's practice is to delete all personally identifiable computer use records at the end of each business day. The System will release internet usage records only as required by law.
